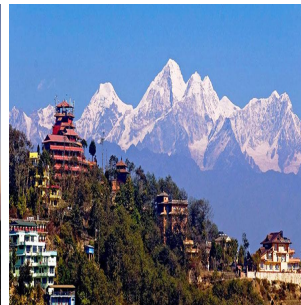


Kathmandu Nagarkot

Day 5. Nagarkot - Bhaktapur - KTM.

Day 6. Transfer, flight to Bhutan..
